## Crawley Hospital, Child Development Centre



**Client:** NHS Property Services

**Project:** Child Development Centre at Crawley Hospital

**Size (m2):** 1,269m<sup>2</sup>

The local health system had long recognised that current accommodation for Child Development Services at Crawley Hospital was no longer suitable. This coupled with substantial increase in the demand for services\* meant that plans were put in place to develop an alternative facility.

gbpartnerships assessed various options for the provision of a new Child Development Centre (CDC), culminating in a fully reconfigured floor of the Yellow Wing of Crawley Hospital. The project is part of NHS Property Services Healthy Places Programme, and the new space provides dedicated, modern, fit-for-purpose accommodation, supporting the delivery of integrated services to more of the local population, reducing waiting times and the need for multiple appointments.

*\*Service need has increased rapidly as diagnostic processes have improved, particularly in relation to autistic spectrum disorders, and more children with increasingly complex health and care needs who would previously have been cared for in a hospital are now managed at home.*

- Project manage the construction delivery and commissioning of the new CDC.
